APRIL MEETING/SPEAKER

April 6th speaker: BG (ret) Jeffery L. Newton Topic: Overview of the Alabama Dept Veteran Affairs

Brigadier General Jeffrey L. Newton (Retired) is the Assistant Commissioner for the Alabama Department of Veterans Affairs located in Montgomery, Alabama. In his current assignment, he is responsible for 63 Veteran Service Offices across the State of Alabama with the primary mission of assisting the nearly 400,000 Alabama Veterans, families, and survivors to receive from the state and federal government all benefits to which they may be entitled to under current laws.

Prior to his current assignment, he was the Director of the Joint Staff of the Alabama National Guard responsible for joint military operations relating to State and National emergencies. His 41-year military career with the United States Air Force and the Alabama Air National Guard included numerous overseas deployments with the 117th Air Refueling Wing located in Birmingham, Alabama, supporting Operations Iraqi Freedom, Enduring Freedom, and Operation Noble Eagle.

His major military awards include the Air Force Distinguished Service Medal, the Legion of Merit, the Air Force and Army Commendation Medals, and the Alabama Distinguished Service Medal. In November 2021, he was inducted into the United States Air Force's Enlisted Heritage Hall - Wall of Fame. He is a graduate of Samford University, and Auburn University

MOAA Legislative Updates By Anne Hartline

MOAA's Mission: To preserve and protect earned benefits for our uniformed services, veterans, their families, and surviving spouses through advocacy, leadership, education and service.

MOAA is the most influential and the most respected military lobby in Washington with 10 full time lobbyists on the Hill advocating for services and benefits. On April 26th more than 200 MOAA leaders from across the United States will participate in MOAA's Advocacy in Action Day visiting all senators and legislators. Every year MOAA provides training for these volunteer chapter and council leaders on three current issues to prepare them for these visits. The first two are discussion topics, and handout information on the third issue is provided to be left with the law makers. The topics this year are:

#1. Restore Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH)

Currently, our troops receive only 95% of BAH based on the housing analysis. They deserve 100%!

#2. Reverse the TRICARE Pharmacy Network Cuts

14 thousand independent pharmacies were cut from the network. This cut reduced choices and many options for many TRICARE beneficiaries. Some long-term care residents no longer have access to a network pharmacy to meet their needs.

#3. Support the All-Volunteer Force

Recruiting challenges continue to make the news. Erosion of benefits and troop cuts detract from service. Our nation must take better care of those who serve, or have served, to include families and survivors.

Among other issues currently included in ongoing advocacy are:

- Repeal the recoupment of last month's paycheck after retiree's death.
- Continue to improve servicemembers' and veterans' Group Life Insurance.
- Improve Dependency and Indemnity Compensation (DIC) baseline to align with other government entitlements' baseline of 55%. Currently, a disabled veteran receives 43%.

We all need to become active advocates! Numbers influence votes in Congress, and MOAA's 350,000 members all need to help. What can we do:

DoD: No Further Extensions Planned for Expired ID Cards!

Many of us have had our ID cards automatically extended due to the COVID. However, that indefinite extension is now ending on January 31, 2022. If your ID card has an expiration date that is past or expires this month, you will need to renew it ASAP.
