MOAA and its affiliated chapters and councils are non-partisan.



**The Ides of March** is best known as the date on which Julius Caesar was assassinated in 44 BC. Caesar was stabbed to death at a meeting of the Senate. As many as 60 conspirators, led by Brutus and Cassius, were involved. A seer (fortuneteller) had warned that harm would come to Caesar on the Ides of March (March 15). On his way to the Theatre of Pompey where he would be assassinated, Caesar passed the seer and joked, *"Well, the Ides of March are come,"* implying that the prophecy had not been fulfilled, to which the seer replied *"Aye, they are come, but they are not gone."* This meeting is famously dramatized in <u>Shakespeare</u>'s play <u>Julius Caesar</u>, when Caesar is warned by the <u>soothsayer</u> to *"beware the Ides of March."* 

For Years the Ides of March (March 15<sup>th</sup>) was the day our Income Tax was due into the Federal Coffers. The due date was changed to April 15<sup>th</sup> and this year it is Monday, April 17<sup>th</sup>. Matthew 22:15-22 raises the question about paying Taxes. 
