Hello everyone,

Welcome to August! The summer is flying by with all the heat, rain, thunderstorms, and wind.

I recently attended an Alabama Board of Nursing meeting and heard a fabulous speaker teach about the bonding between animals and humans. I want to share it with you.

Dr. William S. Pope, DNP, RN, D. Min is an associate clinical professor at Auburn University. The title of the class is "Human Animal Bond and Health. We all need to do what we can to stay healthy. Maybe having a pet dog is an answer!

What is a Bond? A bond is a relationship with someone, or something based on shared feelings, interests, or experiences. Some bonding examples are husband-wife, parent-child, friend-friend, human-animal. Some characteristics of bonding include continuous, reciprocal, voluntary, trustworthy, caring, and beneficial to both. Think about a pet you have had or have now. The human-animal bond is a mutually beneficial and dynamic relationship between people and animals that is influenced by behaviors that are essential to the health and well-being of both. This includes, but it is not limited to emotional, psychological, and physical interactions of people, animals, and the environment.

What are some Human-Animal Bond Facts? Research shows that senior citizens who own dogs go to the doctor less than those who do not own a dog. A Medicare study shows dog owners had 21 % fewer doctor visits (Seigel, 1990). Children who are exposed to dogs show more empathy than children who are not (Ascione, 1992).

Another reason this subject came to my mind is a neighbor, who lost her husband last September, has recently told me she is thinking about adopting a dog for a companion.

Whatever chance or reason happens to you to help deal with loneliness, lack of purpose, sadness, or grief, may you embrace that situation so you will heal and be healthy. It may even be a sweet puppy! God bless you!
