Speaker: BG (ret) Jeffery L. Newton Topic: Overview of the Alabama Dept Veteran Affairs

Brigadier General Jeffrey L. Newton (Retired) is the Assistant Commissioner for the Alabama Department of Veterans Affairs located in Montgomery, Alabama. In his current assignment, he is responsible for 63 Veteran Service Offices across the State of Alabama with the primary mission of assisting the nearly 400,000 Alabama Veterans, families, and survivors to receive from the state and federal government all benefits to which they may be entitled to under current laws.

Prior to his current assignment, he was the Director of the Joint Staff of the Alabama National Guard responsible for joint military operations relating to State and National emergencies. His 41-year military career with the United States Air Force and the Alabama Air National Guard included numerous overseas deployments with the 117th Air Refueling Wing located in Birmingham, Alabama, supporting Operations Iraqi Freedom, Enduring Freedom, and Operation Noble Eagle.

His major military awards include the Air Force Distinguished Service Medal, the Legion of Merit, the Air Force and Army Commendation Medals, and the Alabama Distinguished Service Medal. In November 2021, he was inducted into the United States Air Force's Enlisted Heritage Hall - Wall of Fame. He is a graduate of Samford University, and Auburn University.

Eligibility: Honorably serving, former, or retired Warrants, Chief Warrants, or commissioned officers of the armed forces (Regular, Reserve, National Guard) as well as current, former, or retired USCG, NOAA, USPHS commissioned officers and surviving spouses from all branches are eligible to join MOAA. PURCHASING INDIVIDUAL TICKETS

- 1. From the event website above, select "Purchase Tickets" button on the right side of the page.
- 2. Select "Individual Ticket" and enter the name, email address and phone number of the ticket holder. If you have been invited to be at the head table, you may select "Head Table".
- 3. Select the applicable group from the list (scroll down to see the entire list). Click add ticket which is on the left side after the last group name.
- 4. You can click "Add Another Ticket" to purchase additional tickets and repeat steps 2 and 3.
- 5. When finished adding tickets, click next, fill in your contact information, and pay.
- 6. Each ticket holder will be emailed their individual ticket.
- 7. About a week prior to the event, all ticket holders will receive an email with their table assignments.

PURCHASING A TABLE

- 1. From the event website above, select "Purchase a Table".
- 2. Check the box if you will be sitting at this table.
- 3. Select the applicable group from the list (scroll down to see the entire list).
- 4. Click next, fill in your contact information and pay.
- 5. You can enter the names and email addresses of the other table attendees now or wait on the email with a link to do it later.

After purchasing a table, you will receive an email with a link to invite your guests. Click on the link and you will be taken to the page where you will enter their names and email addresses. When submitted, they will receive an invitation and they can choose confirm or deny.

Confirmed guests will be routed back to the event website to confirm email and receive ticket.

As the table host, you will receive a notification of any declining.
