
Statement of Publication





All of our surviving spouses have endured many military moves during our spouses' assignment changes. As a surviving spouse, many stories can be shared about times when trying to get employment when another move was apparent.

In the July 2024 MOAA magazine, the article, "Supporting Spouses" talks about the readiness impact of military spouse employment. It shares stories of military spouses having difficulty in employment when change-of-station orders are received. Hidden barriers and inequities in spouse employment become apparent.

Spouse Maria Donnelly shared, "I Lost my Identity; I Felt Like I Wasn't Contributing to Our Family." There seemed to be a hesitancy in hiring spouses. The word, "Dependent" often conveyed undereducated or inexperienced. Frequent military moves are intended to rotate talent, advance leadership and improve skills for the soldier. This concept should apply to the military spouse as well. It is nearly impossible to get ahead when one is always starting over. One thing is certainly true, military spouses are resourceful!


